Every Child Ready to Read Skill

Talking

Try to remember to make good eye contact with your child when you speak to them. Babies and young children love to have your attention and getting it will encourage them to keep communicating with you. Another way to teach good communication skills is by taking turns. It can be hard to wait for a toddler to finish a thought, but try to give them the opportunity to finish speaking rather than jumping in to speed things up. This will build their confidence in their own ability to communicate.
