



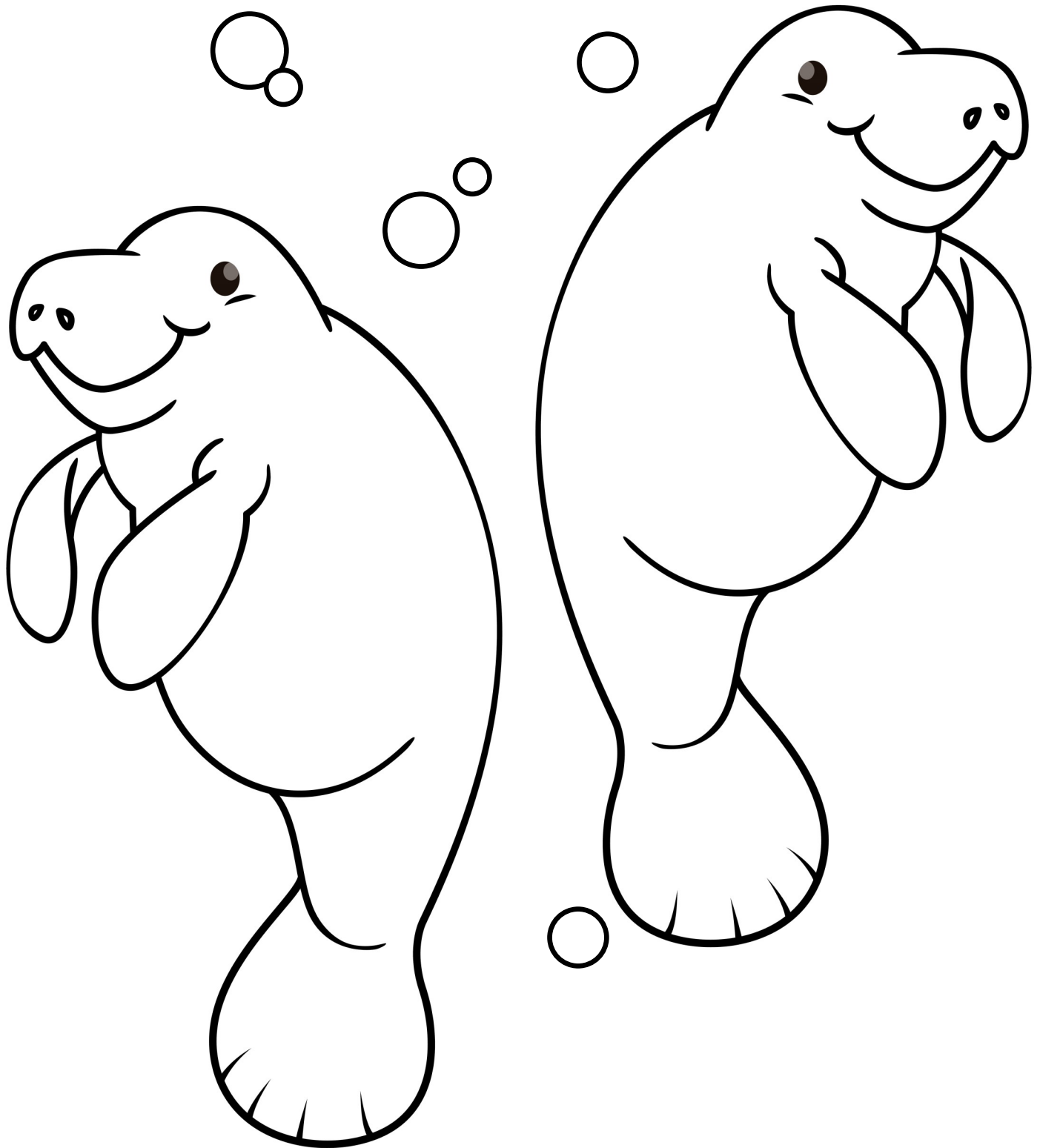

Feel the way the wind does blow...on a windy day

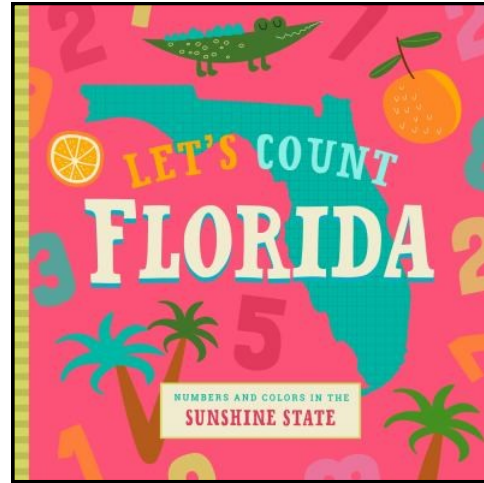
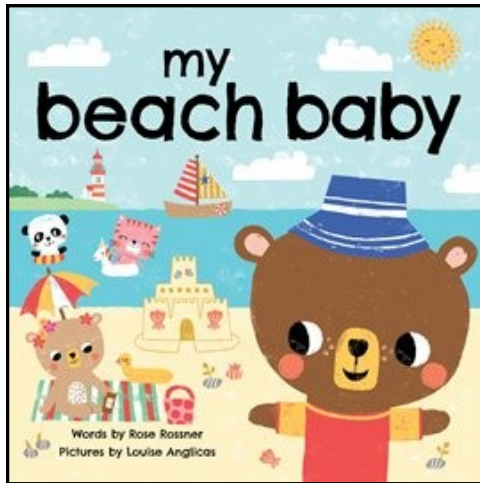
We move slowly when it's hot...on a hot, hot day.

Snuggle up when it's cold...on a cold, cold day.

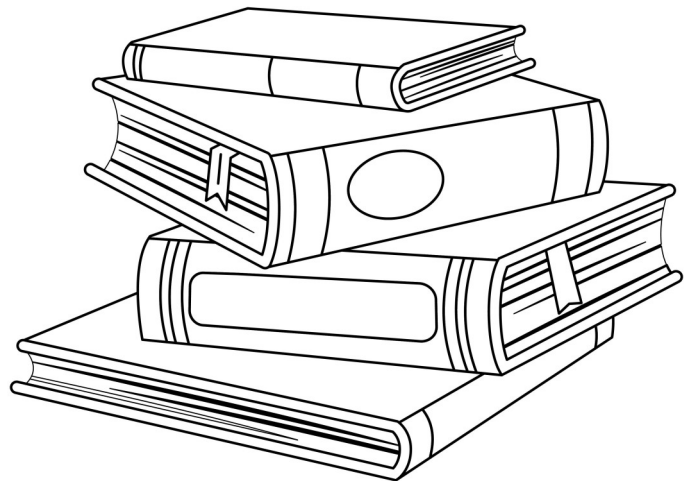

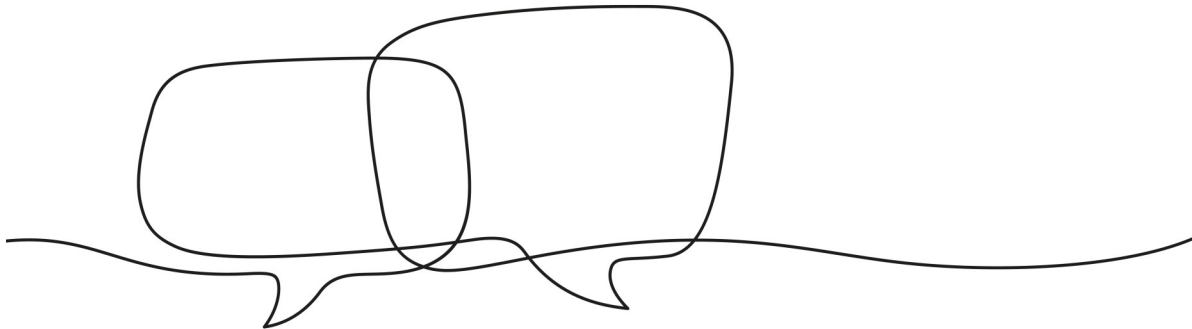
